## **Procedures**

- **Shoulder arthroscopy:** Bone spurs, impingement, tendinitis, rotator cuff tears, labral tears, SLAP tears, biceps tendon tears, shoulder dislocations, AC joint separations, frozen shoulder/adhesive capsulitis, etc.
- Knee arthroscopy: Meniscus and other cartilage tears, ACL and other ligament tears, patella dislocations, etc.
- Elbow surgery: Biceps tendon tears, UCL tears (Tommy John surgery), etc.
- Bone marrow aspirate (stem cell) injections: Knee arthritis and other needs
- Platelet-rich plasma (PRP) injections: Tennis elbow, patella tendinopathy, knee arthritis, etc.
